Narrative Summary of Project:

Based on the original survey of community needs one of the local JCB is to cooperate with other groups, individuals and community organizations to preserve community history. To meet this goal, the JCB worked with the North Daviess School and Jameson Alumni Association to display more than 60 composite senior pictures that had been taken down from the school walls and were in storage. The senior pictures could not be seen by students and visitors to the school. JCB volunteers researched ways to display and preserve the pictures. The JCB, North Daviess School, Jameson Alumni Association, Lions Club, and individuals donated the money to purchase a heavy-duty metal display system with swinging frames. JCB volunteers worked with high school students and faculty members to remove the pictures from the original frames, to place them into the new picture frames, and to hang them in the school lunch room, where they can be viewed by all. The placement of the pictures in the frames was completed January 2008. The pictures were in place to be enjoyed at the annual Jameson Alumni Banquet in May 2008. Based on the success of this project, the Alumni Association, North Daviess School and JCB are planning to purchase another set of the hanging frames to hold the remaining and future class pictures.
