Kids In Motion began in 1996 as a result of a meeting called by local law enforcement officials, and other community leaders to address rising concerns about gang presence and participation in Louisiana. Members of the business community, together with representatives of the non-profit sector, proposed a summer youth program to counter these concerns.
