Narrative summary of project:

Mayor's Youth Council was created thirty-one years ago to provide an outlet for youthful energy and to challenge students to become leaders in their community. MYC also assists youth who are in trouble and need positive reinforcement. The students had a total of 48 projects last year and assisted 20 organizations and provided 1,371 hours of community service to Cabool. Community members and Cabool Schools helped with their travel expenses. The youth pay for nearly all of their own projects that are not associated with CRG, Chamber or Park Board. They received their MYC shirts from the City last year which they wear as a uniform to MYC events. They worked for a Farm Fest Road Crew t-shirt and a Freedom Celebration t-shirt as well. The City sponsors a \$500 scholarship for an outstanding senior member annually to assist with post-high school education expenses.
