The City of Higbee built a dog pound on the out skirts of town in the early 1990's. Since that time the City of Higbee has used this structure to house all dogs that have been caught due to their owners neglect. The City of Higbee was having issues at the old dog pound of break-ins due to disgruntled citizens being unhappy about their animals being detained by the dog catcher. The City of Higbee decided in Summer 2008 to renovate the unused Water Plant building to make a more safe and secure housing facility for the dogs that were caught around town. In May 2009, the new city dog pound was completed and can now house seven dogs in a comfortable state approved building.
