The Missouri Youth Civic Leaders Summit is a statewide gathering of teens and adults who are ready to engage with others on topics of leadership, service, and LIFE! YCLS teams can be made up of local teens and adults from 4-H SPIN, community clubs, councils, schools, after-school programs, community organizations, or countywide groups.

Teams will gather with 20-30 other teen/adult groups from across Missouri and other states to network, learn, energize, and plan for action in youth-adult partnerships! Youth-adult partnerships are a powerful and promising way for young people and adults to develop their leadership while engaging in thoughtful and meaningful work together.

Summit teams will be challenged to identify a project or event they want to work on in 2019 to benefit their community and boost their readiness for the next stage of leadership and LIFE!

2019 team registration (for MCB coordinators)

MCB coordinators: you are invited to organize a team of youth and adults from your community to attend YCLS 2019!

MCB registration will be online from Nov 20, 2018 to Feb 1, 2019.

Team members will register separately, but should contact you (their MCB coordinator) first.

MCB coordinators can track team registrations with the [Summit Team Roster](#) and send to Teresa Keller by Feb. 1.

Teams are made up of students ages 14-18 and an adult leader/chaperone (can be MCB coordinator, teacher, volunteer, parent, or community leader).
Team range in size from 3-10 members (1-2 adults, 2-8 youth).

Youth registration is \$170.00 (contact MCB for discounts that may apply).
Includes Fri/Sat lodging, meals, conference materials, and most recreation options.
[EDGE Course](#) recreation option is \$25.00 extra added to registration.

Adult registration is FREE – one adult chaperone for the first 2-5 students to register. Teams with 6 or more students can register 2 adult chaperones FREE.

Adult team leaders must be age 21 & up and complete a [Family Care Registry Background Screening](#). Send Fill-able PDF Form to gracesk@missouri.edu by Feb 1, 2019.

Summit schedule runs from 4-5pm check-in on Friday, March 1, to 11am closing on Sunday, March 3.
